



**TASK:** Fairy tales like “Goldilocks and the Three Bears”, “Little Red Riding Hood”, and “Cinderella” are stories that you have grown up hearing and reading. You know them well, but have you ever thought what the characters from one story might say to the characters of another story if they were to meet? What would Goldilocks and Cinderella say to each other? Would they become good friends? It’s very interesting to think about.

Your task is to complete the graphic organizers about characters and to write a friendly letter from any character from a favorite fairy tale to another character out of a second fairy tale.

The first graphic organizer allows you to start thinking about each character you have chosen: personal traits, how they act, what they say, and what they think. The second graphic organizer then lets you think of the two characters together: what they like about each other, the interests that they might share, and what they might like to do together.

When the graphic organizers are completed, you will have enough information to write a friendly letter from one character to the other. Be creative in your thinking, but follow the form for a friendly letter and use correct spelling and punctuation. The Rubric for a Friendly Letter will help you to know what is expected of you.
